HIGHLIGHTS OF THE INTINERARY...

JUNEAU, AK Our first stop will be the capital city of Juneau, one of Alaska's oldest cities established before the 1898 Klondike gold rush. Here you can spend the day visiting the Alaska State Museum and Sealaska Heritage Institute, or if you like, learn to "mush" with the best on a dog-sledding excursion.



HUBBARD GLACIER Departure is at 9PM and we head 200 miles NW of Juneau to Hubbard Glacier off the coast of Yakutat. Hubbard Glacier is the largest tidewater glacier in North America.

SITKA Departure is at 6PM and we'll head south to Sitka, AK on Baranof Island where we spend the day touring. Some points of interest are Sitka National Historic Park and The Alaskan Raptor Museum.



KETCHIKAN Next stop is Ketchikan, arrival at 7AM! Spend the day in Alaska's first city and the last frontier. Ketchikan is the southernmost entrance to the famed inside passage; a network of waterways that snake through some of the most jaw-droppingly beautiful wilderness in the world. Don't miss downtown Ketchikan, a national historic district. Departure time is 1PM.



VICTORIA From Ketchikan we'll cruise to Victoria, the capital city of British Columbia. One of the oldest cities in the pacific northwest and rich in history of the northwest expansion; from Vancouver Island's first nations and the settlement of Victoria to the Gold Rush.



SEATTLE Finally, we dock in Seattle at 7AM and the end of our Alaskan Adventure!
